

**EWTN CATHOLIC RADIO NETWORK  
RADIO NETWORK AFFILIATION AGREEMENT**

This AFFILIATION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into this 31<sup>st</sup> day of **December, 2010** by and between ETERNAL WORD TELEVISION NETWORK, INC. ("EWTN"), an Alabama nonprofit corporation, residing at 5817 Old Leeds Road, Irondale, Alabama 35210, and **Pax Catholic Communications, Inc.** ("Affiliate"), a Florida nonprofit corporation, residing at 1779 N.W. 28 Street, Miami, FL 33142.

WHEREAS, EWTN is the operator of the EWTN Global Catholic Radio Network ("Network") through which it provides radio programming ("Network Programs" or "Network Programming" as the case may be) to affiliated radio station(s) ("EWTN Affiliates");

WHEREAS, Affiliate is the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") licensee of the station (the "Station") identified in Exhibit One to this Agreement and may also operate an Internet site(s) on the World Wide Web associated with the Station ("Affiliate Web Site(s)");

WHEREAS, Affiliate is familiar with the Network Programming and believes that its broadcast over the Station will serve the public interest so it desires to become an EWTN Catholic Radio Affiliate pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, it is agreed as follows:

I. **Radio Network Affiliation.**

A. **Rights/Benefits/Obligations.** EWTN hereby grants to Affiliate, and Affiliate hereby accepts, the non-exclusive royalty free right and license to distribute the Network Programming (i) via the Station up to 168 hours per week and (ii) via its Affiliated Web Site; and such further rights and benefits, subject to such attendant obligations and limitations, as are set forth below. This license is granted provided that there shall be no fees, duties, or commissions of any kind payable by either party to the other for the broadcast of Network Programming.

B. **Broadcast of Network Programming.** Affiliate will broadcast the Network Programming via the Station for the minimum number of hours per day, which shall be:

- 80% of the broadcast hours per week, averaging 19 hours per day measured weekly, per calendar week, seven days per week, unless the Station is a daytimer then minimum is 80% of the broadcast hours per day, seven days per week.
- Affiliate must carry EWTN's "live" weekday strips in their entirety, five days per week, Monday through Friday. The live "weekday" strips consist of the EWTN-branded live strips which air in the afternoon and the evening, including EWTN Open Line (3:00-5:00PM Eastern), and EWTN live shows on the "live strip" in the evening (8:00-9:00PM Eastern).

Affiliate shall promptly notify Network if a Station's normal broadcast transmission is interrupted, interfered with or in any way impaired and shall describe the measures being taken to correct such problem. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, in the event Affiliate fails to satisfy its minimum Network Programming obligation of 133 hours in any calendar week, then Network

shall have the right to terminate this Agreement in its entirety upon seven (7) days advance notice. Affiliate understands that it does not have the right to carry any other EWTN programming unless Affiliate enters into a separate agreement to do so with EWTN.

(i) **Broadcast Quality.** The Network Programming shall be broadcast with the same quality as it is provided to the Affiliate such that a reasonable listener's perception of the Programming would not perceive a degradation in audio quality.

(ii) **Main Channel.** The Network Programming shall be broadcast on the main channel of the Station.

(iii) **Non-Network Programming.** Other programming carried on the Station shall not be disparaging of the Catholic Faith or the Mission Statement of EWTN or EWTN. Such programming need not be religious, but should be family-friendly and of a quality and content consistent with the Network Programming.

(iv) **Other Program Streams, information, Sideband, and digital information.** Materials and information added to sideband channels, IBOC, RMS, or any other similar technologies that provide other audio programs, data, and information to the listener shall not be inconsistent with the Mission Statement of EWTN, as attached in Exhibit Two, and may only be added with the written permission of Network, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

C. **Affiliation Term.** Unless earlier terminated pursuant to the terms of this Agreement, the "Term" of this Agreement shall consist of, collectively, the Initial Term of Five (5) years and any number of Renewal Terms of one (1) year each. The Initial Term shall commence as of the date hereof. The Renewal Term(s) shall commence automatically for the renewal period (each a "Renewal Term") after the expiration of the Initial Term, and each Renewal Term, unless either:

(i) this Agreement is terminated earlier in accordance with the terms hereof, or

(ii) either party hereto provides written notice to the other party hereto of its intent to terminate this Agreement with sixty (60) day advance notice.

D. **Benefits**

1. **Marketing and Cross Promotion** – As a Full Time Affiliate, Affiliate will be provided with marketing support by EWTN. Such support shall include Affiliate's use of EWTN promotional materials, prepared print advertisements, premium items, seasonal campaign and event materials, EWTN program schedules, localized EWTN radio spots, access to marketing section of EWTN website, and Affiliate listing (includes hyperlink to Affiliate website) on EWTN website. EWTN reserves the right to determine what constitutes a reasonable quantity of free materials, above which additional quantities would be provided at cost to Affiliate.

(i) Affiliate must include Network Logo, as provided by Network, on its Programming guides, printed and internet. Network shall include Affiliate call sign, logo, and information on its web site.

(ii) Affiliate must create and maintain an accurate Program Guide, which is also available on any Affiliate's web site, that shall clearly identify Network Programming on the grid as sourced from and part of the EWTN Global Catholic Network.

**2. Fund-raising Events** – EWTN will assist with the fund-raising efforts of Full Time Affiliates. Specifically, Affiliate may use EWTN's literature and premium items (at cost), and may request the appearance of EWTN personalities or staff at Affiliate events (subject to availability and at Affiliate's expense).

**3. Kick-off and Launch Support.** EWTN will provide training and assistance with launch activities, including arranging and accompanying Affiliate to have a meeting between Affiliate and the local Ordinary, kick-off promotion and local promotional assistance, training Affiliate on how to obtain and perform local talks at Parishes, and organize and assist in conducting a local kick-off event.

**4. Programming / Production** – Full Time Affiliates will be given radio production support, which includes localized, customized tune-in spots recorded by EWTN personalities promoting Affiliate, promotion of Affiliate on EWTN's television network, and ability to select major live events in addition to regular daily EWTN carriage.

## II. Program Schedule.

A. **Program Description.** EWTN's affiliate programming will consist of a variety of Catholic radio programming.

### B. **Affiliate/Network Undertakings.**

1. **Affiliate Program Grid.** Exhibit Three hereto is Affiliate's Program Grid ("Program Grid") identifying the specific hours daily that Affiliate shall broadcast Network Programming.

2. **Direct Over the Air Broadcast Only.** Affiliate agrees not to authorize, cause, permit or enable Network's Programming to be used for any purpose other than broadcasting by Affiliate. Affiliate also agrees that it will not broadcast Network programming over the facilities of any other broadcast station, translator, or closed circuit network or relay system, or authorize others to do so without EWTN's prior written consent.

3. **Network Feed Not Authorized for Internet Streaming.** Affiliate agrees that it will not stream the Network Programming feed over the internet or other media directly, but it may, if it desires, stream its own broadcast audio on the internet, which includes Network Programming as it is broadcast on the Station. Affiliate understands, and Network **expressly disclaims** any warranties, express or implied, of the Network Programming for suitability or fitness for internet streaming. Affiliate also agrees that it shall be solely responsible for any licensing, rights, tariffs, taxes or other liabilities incurred by streaming its broadcast stream over the internet and shall indemnify Network from any third party claims arising out of or related to the internet streaming of its broadcast signals.

4. **No Audio on Demand, Storage, Podcasts, or Other archived material.** Affiliate agrees that it shall not, without written permission from Network, cause any Network

Programming to be recorded, digitized, and made available to the public by an audio on demand, podcast, or other similar method by which the public may access Network Programming from anything other than the live broadcast stream of the Station(s), whether it be through the broadcast or the internet stream. For the avoidance of doubt, neither Affiliate nor Network shall be responsible for the independent actions of consumers to use methods of or devices for time-shifting or personal recording of Network Programming for their personal use.

5. Except as otherwise provided for herein, as to each Network Program, Affiliate agrees to broadcast each such program in its entirety and without interruption, deletion or addition of any kind.

**5.1 No Deletion or Alteration of Network Program as defined in the Network Clock.** Affiliate agrees that it will not delete any Tag, FMI, ID, acknowledgement of contribution, underwriting credit announcement or network identification run by EWTN in Network Programming. An example of the Network Clock is attached as Exhibit Four.

**5.2 One Day Tape Delay.** Affiliate may store live Network Programming for delayed broadcast so long as the delayed broadcast occurs within twenty-four (24) hours of the live broadcast.

**6. Local Avails and Announcements May Only Run in Affiliate Time Space.** Affiliate agrees that it will not broadcast any non-EWTN announcements in any cleared Network programs except at breaks, joins or departure points specified by EWTN, and except to comply with any applicable rules of the FCC. EWTN shall provide industry-standard tones for breaks, cutaways, and rejoins. Ordinary Network Programming will provide 4 minutes per hour for local station announcements and fifteen (15) seconds for station ID, however, some hours may provide five (5) minutes, which shall be indicated on the Affiliate Program Grid / Network Clock distributed by Network to Affiliates (and an example of which is attached as Exhibit Four). Translators and daytimers may be offered other arrangements, but only on written permission from EWTN. Other arrangements to accommodate Fund drives conducted by the Affiliate for the operation of Station(s), or similar, may be permitted on written permission from Network, which shall not be unreasonably withheld, so long as Affiliate provides the dates of the fund drive and the intended accommodations in writing thirty (30) days in advance of the event.

**7. Public Interest Preemption and FCC.** EWTN and Affiliate each understand that nothing in this Agreement will prevent Affiliate from substituting program material from time to time which, in Affiliate's reasonable good-faith judgment, is of greater local or national importance or as may otherwise be required in accordance with FCC rules. Affiliate agrees that, in the event it rejects or refuses to carry a Network Program in furtherance of a decision made pursuant to this Paragraph and determines to broadcast substitute programming, then it agrees that it will reject, refuse, or substitute such Network programming in its entirety.

**C. Reports.** Affiliate agrees to report to Network, in writing, any significant changes (planned or actual) to the programming grid. Upon Network's request, Affiliate shall confirm its compliance with the then current Program Grid. Affiliate also agrees to report any Network Programming that was not broadcast by Affiliate, if any, within ten (10) days after the end of each calendar month, and any other information concerning clearance of Network Programming as may be requested from time to time by EWTN.

**1. Surveys.** From time to time, at least quarterly, Network shall survey the affiliates regarding the Network Programming and carriage. Affiliate shall complete such surveys and return it to Network, as instructed on the Survey, within 30 days. Affiliate agrees that failure to complete and return a Survey shall be a material breach of this Agreement.

D. **Delivery of Programs.** EWTN agrees that it will make Network Programming available for reception and retransmission by Affiliate via a US domestic satellite in both analog and digital formats. Affiliate agrees that it will be solely responsible for installing, operating and maintaining the appropriate satellite reception (or other reception) facilities, necessary to receive Network Programming. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, Affiliate and any third party upon whom Affiliate is dependent for transmission of the Network Programming to Affiliate's transmit site, shall furnish, at its own cost and expense, all equipment and facilities, including but not limited to satellite reception and decoding equipment, necessary for the receipt of the signal containing the Network Programming and the retransmission thereof.

E. **Continuation of Program Service.** EWTN and Affiliate each understand that subsequent to the termination of this agreement, Affiliate shall not continue to broadcast Network Programming and EWTN is not obligated to continue to furnish, any programs which EWTN may have offered and which Affiliate may have accepted during their affiliation.

### III. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES.

A. Affiliate represents and warrants that (i) it is an entity duly organized and validly existing under the laws of the state of its organization; (ii) it has the power and authority to enter into this Agreement and to perform fully its obligations hereunder; (iii) it is under no contractual or other legal obligation which shall in any way interfere with its full, prompt and complete performance hereunder; (iv) Affiliate owns, manages, or otherwise controls each Station; and (v) each Station is, and during the Initial Term and all Renewal Terms will be, duly licensed to broadcast using the facilities specified in Exhibit One.

B. EWTN represents and warrants that (i) it is a corporation duly organized and validly existing under the laws of the state of its incorporation; (ii) it has the corporate power and authority to enter into this Agreement and to perform fully its obligations hereunder; and (iii) it is under no contractual or other legal obligation which shall in any way interfere with its full, prompt and complete performance hereunder.

### IV. Affiliate Responsibilities.

A. **Transfer or Assignment of Facilities.** Affiliate agrees to notify EWTN in writing within thirty (30) days after the filing of any application for the transfer or assignment of any interest in Affiliate with the FCC. Affiliate understands that EWTN in its sole unfettered discretion may terminate this Agreement upon such assignment of license or transfer of control.

B. **Licenses.** Affiliate agrees that it will be solely responsible for maintaining all licenses necessary for broadcasting, carriage on Affiliate's web site, and any other means by which Station's signal is distributed the Network Programming including licensing all music in the repertory of ASCAP, BMI, and SESAC that may be used in Network Programming.

C. **Notice of Broadcast Failures.** Affiliate agrees to notify EWTN immediately if Station fails to broadcast for a period of time longer than one hour.

D. **Cessation of Operation.** Affiliate agrees to notify EWTN immediately if Affiliate ceases broadcasting for a period of 7 consecutive days for any reason. Affiliate understands that EWTN may terminate this Agreement anytime thereafter upon forty-eight (48) hours written notice to Affiliate.

V. **Promotional Rights.** Affiliate agrees that EWTN may use Affiliate's name, Station call sign(s) and frequency(ies) in connection with promotion of EWTN, the Network Programming and Affiliate's association with it for the term of this Agreement. Affiliate acknowledges that EWTN is the owner of all trademarks, slogans, logos, service indicia, and tradenames (collectively the "Marks") used in connection with the Network Programming and that EWTN has the exclusive right to control the quality of all wares and services in connection with which the Marks are used. Affiliate shall have the right to use the Marks in routine promotional materials, such as printed and electronic program guides, program listings and web Site(s); provided that Affiliate shall not use the Marks in connection with any fundraising activities without Network's prior written consent. Affiliate shall not alter, amend, or edit the Marks, and Affiliate shall not use the Marks for any other purpose than to positively promote the availability of Network Programming with Affiliate. Affiliate agrees that it has not acquired nor will it acquire by operation of this Agreement any proprietary or other rights in the Marks or any other names and trademarks currently used or to be used by Network in the future.

VI. **Unauthorized Use.** Affiliate shall not, for pay or otherwise, record, copy, duplicate, retransmit and/or authorize the recording, copying, duplication or retransmission of any portion of the Network Programming without Network's prior written consent. Should Affiliate become aware of a third party performing such unauthorized recording, copying, duplication or retransmission, other than for private home use, Affiliate shall promptly notify Network and extend its full cooperation to assist Network to enforce its rights against such unauthorized use.

VII. **Termination.**

A. EWTN may terminate this Agreement for:

- i. Affiliate's broadcast of any material inconsistent with the magisterial teaching of the Roman Catholic Church;
- ii. any material breach of this Agreement by Affiliate;
- iv. a failure by Affiliate to substantially broadcast programming it notified EWTN would be cleared; or
- v. any action or inaction of Affiliate which in the reasonable opinion of EWTN would bring disrepute to EWTN and its Mission as stated in Exhibit Two attached hereto, including but not limited to any major change in Affiliate's program format.

B. In addition, either party may terminate this Agreement, effective at any time after the occurrence of any one or more of the following events:



- i. at any time, if it discontinues the services upon which this Agreement is based;
  - ii. the other party files an assignment in bankruptcy or is petitioned into bankruptcy and such petition has not been dismissed, stayed or withdrawn within thirty days of its filing;
  - iii. a receiver, receiver-manager, trustee, liquidator or custodian is duly appointed to administer all or a substantial part of the business of the other party, which appointment is not vacated within thirty days; or
  - iv. the other party makes an assignment for the benefit of its creditors and such assignment is not withdrawn within thirty days of its filing.
- C. Either party may terminate this Agreement if, after notice and reasonable opportunity to cure, the other party is in material default of its obligations under the Agreement.
- D. Either party may terminate this Agreement, either during the initial term or during any subsequent renewal term, by providing sixty days advance written notice of termination.

VIII. **Indemnification.** Affiliate shall indemnify Network from and against any and all claims, liabilities, costs and expenses arising out of the distribution of the Network Programming pursuant to this Agreement or arising out of or related to a breach of this Agreement by Affiliate to the extent that such claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses are based upon alleged libel, slander, defamation, invasion of the right of privacy or violation or infringement of copyright arising out of any deletions, additions or alterations to the Network Programming by the Affiliate. IN NO EVENT SHALL AFFILIATE BE LIABLE, BY INDEMNIFICATION OR OTHERWISE, FOR ANY SPECIAL, INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY LOSS OF PROFIT, LOSS OF USE OR BUSINESS INTERRUPTION.

IX. **EWTN's Indemnification.** EWTN shall indemnify and save harmless Affiliate from and against all liabilities arising, directly or indirectly, from any claim related to the content of the Network Programs, provided that this obligation shall be a nullity in the event Affiliate changes the content of such programming or otherwise breaches this Agreement. IN NO EVENT SHALL EWTN BE LIABLE, BY INDEMNIFICATION OR OTHERWISE, FOR ANY SPECIAL, INDIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY LOSS OF PROFIT, LOSS OF USE OR BUSINESS INTERRUPTION.

X. **Force Majeure.** Neither party shall have any liability to the other party for any failure to perform hereunder if such failure is due to: an act of God; inevitable accident; fire; lockout; strike or other labor dispute; riot or civil commotion; act of government or government instrumentality (whether federal, state or local); act of terrorism; failure of performance by a common carrier; failure in whole or in part of technical facilities; or other cause (excluding financial inability or difficulty of any kind) beyond such party's reasonable control (any of the foregoing, a "Force Majeure Event"). If a party has been unable to perform its obligations under this Agreement by reason of force majeure for at least ninety (90) consecutive days, or one hundred and twenty (120) days in the aggregate during the course of a Term, either party to this

Agreement shall thereupon have the right to terminate this Agreement upon giving thirty (30) days notice to the other party.

XI. **Notices.** Any required notice or other communication, except for the monthly reports, will be sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, or over-night air courier service or same day delivery service, to the addresses specified below (or at such other address as specified by each party from time to time):

All notices hereunder shall be in writing and delivered by hand or sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, fax, or by an overnight delivery service to the receiving party at its address set forth below or as otherwise designated by written notice. Such notices or communications shall be deemed to have been given as of the date of personal delivery, or if mailed, the date the return receipt is signed or the date on which delivery is refused, or if delivered by overnight delivery or facsimile, on the date of receipt. The monthly reports may be sent by telecopy, email, or by first class mail to EWTN at the address specified from time to time by EWTN.

XII. **No Assignment or Delegation.** Affiliate agrees not to assign any right under this Agreement or delegate any duty under this Agreement without the consent in writing of EWTN.

XIII. **Governing Law.** The substantive laws of the State of Alabama will govern this Agreement, without reference to the principles of conflicts of law in effect in such State.

XIV. **Waiver/Modifications.** No modification or waiver of any provision of this Agreement will be effective unless in writing and signed by the party adversely affected, and such waiver and consent will be effective only as to the specific instance and purpose for which given. No





amendment or modification of this Agreement shall be binding unless made in writing and executed by Affiliate and EWTN.

XV. **Entire Agreement/Captions.** This Agreement represents the entire understanding of the parties, supercedes all other prior understandings or agreements between the parties, and may not be modified or amended, except by a written instrument signed by each of the parties. The captions and headings in this Agreement are for convenience and reference purposes only and do not affect the meaning or interpretation of this Agreement in any way.

XVI. **No Agency.** The parties are independent contractors with respect to each other. Affiliate shall not be, nor shall hold itself out to be, the agent of EWTN under this Agreement. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed to create, and the parties do not intend to create, any relationship of partners or joint venturers as between Affiliate and EWTN with respect to this Agreement. All rights to the Network Programming and all of its elements are to remain with EWTN and are not acquired by Affiliate, except to the specific extent otherwise provided in the Agreement.

XVII. **Specific Performance.** The parties agree that the services to be provided by Affiliate hereunder are specific and unique in character and furthermore that a failure by Affiliate to fulfill its commitments, undertakings and other agreements under this Agreement, will cause irreparable damage to Network which cannot be compensated in monetary damages. Therefore, Affiliate agrees that Network may seek specific performance of Affiliate's obligations hereunder as an appropriate remedy in the event of a breach of the terms hereof.

XVIII. **Binding Agreement.** This Agreement, when executed by all the parties, shall constitute a binding agreement with respect to all of the matters set forth herein. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of, and shall be binding upon, the parties hereto and their respective successors and permitted assigns.

XIX. **Counterparts.** This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all of which, taken together, shall constitute one and the same agreement.

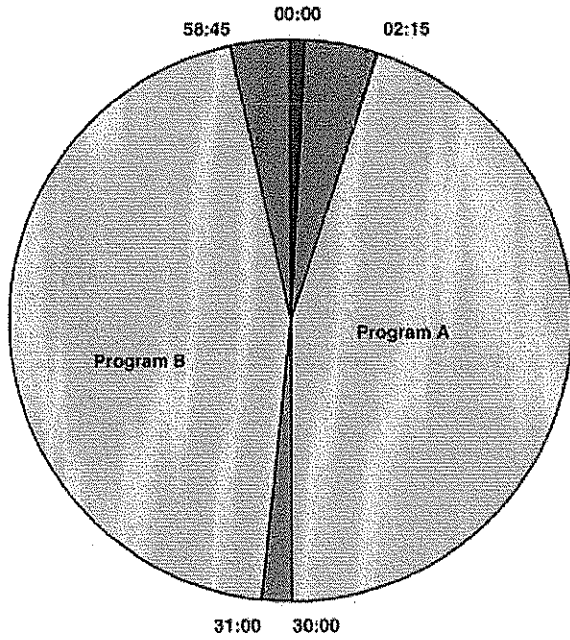
